



LEAN-TO OCCUPANCY GUIDELINES



WHO CAN USE THE LEAN-TOs

Youth campers given priority to stay in lean-tos over adult campers. If a lean-to is still available after all youth have been assigned a lean-to then adults may use.



WHO CAN SHARE A LEAN-TO

Youth campers of the same gender within 2 years of age of each other or adult campers of the same gender.

Cub scout parents and their children may share a lean-to. If there are enough lean-tos for all other youth.



WHO CANNOT SHARE A LEAN-TO

Campers of the opposite gender are not allowed to stay in the same lean-to. (unless they are married to each other)

Members of 2 different families may not share the same lean-to.

*Example: Dad and son of one family cannot share a lean-to with a dad and a son of another family.

Scouts BSA youth and parents are not allowed to share the same lean-to.

Adult leaders and youth are not allowed to share the same lean-to.

HEALTH AND SAFETY GUIDELINES



NO OPEN FLAMES OR HEATERS

Open flames like candles, stoves and heaters are not allowed inside of lean-to structures.



NO NAILS OR CARVING IN WOOD

Nails, screws or thumb tacks may not be used to hang tarps or other items in or onto lean-to structure. Carving or cutting into the wood is not allowed.



NO FOOD ALLOWED

Food is not allowed inside of lean-tos, food and food trash draw in wildlife. Food should be properly stored in trailer or food storage containers.



CAMPSITE CHECK OUT

All trash should be picked up and lean-tos swept out. Mattresses are to be turned up onto their sides. Campfires are to be properly extinguished and fire bucket and shovel are to be returned to firewood shelter.
